ATU LOCAL 1005 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

This scholarship is open each year to the children of active and retired members of ATU 1005.

The Scholarship Selection:

Scholarships to aid in the attainment of a bachelor's degree or a two-year vocational/technical/associate degree are determined by a lottery among eligible applicants. Names will be drawn at the **May 22, 2018** A.M. membership meeting.

Amount of the Awards:

Awards to applicants are \$1,250 per academic year paid directly to the accredited college or vocational/technical school. Each award is given for a specific period of two (2) years, for a total of \$2,500 per award. There will be four (4) awards given per year to eligible applicants.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Any Applicant Must Be-

The son, daughter, stepchild or legally adopted child of a 1005 member.

Only one scholarship per applicant will be awarded.

If an applicant's name is not chosen, the applicant may reapply prior to their first, second, or third year of post-secondary education.

The Applicant

Must have one parent with two years, since date of hire of continuous service and be in good standing membership in Local 1005, up to and including the application deadline of **May 11, 2018**.

The 1005 member (parent) must maintain continuous good standing membership throughout the life of the award. In the event that the parent loses "good-standing," the son or daughter shall lose eligibility based on a per-year basis. Eligibility will be retained if the parent dies after the son or daughter is awarded a scholarship, provided the parent had two years of "continuous good-standing membership" at the time of death.

- High School Diploma or equivalent

- Applicants are eligible up to and including age 21 at application deadline.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: **(CONTINUED)**

- Applicants already enrolled in a two or four year program must have held a minimum “C” average for the previous full-time post-secondary education completed.

Must plan to take a regular college or vocational/technical/associate program on a full-time basis, maintaining qualifying grades (minimum “C” average).

Ineligible Applicants Include

Applicants who do not intend to work without interruption, for a bachelor’s degree or completion of a vocational/technical certification/associate degree.

Graduate students.

Applicants who do not plan to enroll in an accredited college or vocational/technical school.

How to apply:

To be valid, an application must be submitted on the appropriate form. Applications for the **2018** competition may be obtained from your Executive Board Member, the Union Office or at www.atu1005.com. Requests for applications should be made as early as possible.

Applications submitted must be received by the Union Office postmarked no later than **May 11, 2018**. Applications postmarked later than **May 11, 2018** will NOT be considered. No exceptions will be permitted!

The ATU 1005 Executive Board shall be the final/binding authority on all matters pertaining to this scholarship. Additionally, the terms of scholarship may change from year to year.

All Scholarship Applicants are Advised

To obtain guidance from their high school teachers and counselors in pursuing a college education or for attending vocational/technical school.

Not to wait until awards are announced before making other plans for financing a college or vocational/technical school education.

To apply early for scholarships or awards from several other sources, and

To make early application for admission to at least three colleges.
